This year, we're kicking off an adventure through the New Testament, reading it chronologically together. Here's some helpful info as we begin:

It's simple to do! Read one chapter a day — five days a week.

We made an easy chart to help track your progress. It's also packed with links to insightful book guides, videos and articles from The Bible Project. Just saying, these book guides have excellent information and a summary video for the book you're about to read.

Yes, this reading plan is for only five days a week. That means we can switch it up on weekends, maybe get into the Old Testament, or prepare for an upcoming Bible study or review Sunday's sermon — just follow where the Lord leads.

Of course, feel free to listen to an audio version as you read from your own Bible. YouVersion is a great app to facilitate this.

Some ideas to consider to dig deeper include:

- Pray before reading, inviting Him to open our eyes, ears and heart to hear what He has to say today
- Highlight or underline words or verses that stand out to you
- Capture the big idea of a sentence, paragraph or chapter
- Take notes of new discoveries
- Choose a verse-a-day or a verse-a-week to memorize — His Word is amazing so let's keep it close in our heart. It's helpful for piercing the darkness, offering comfort during difficult times, transforming our way of thinking, strengthening our faith and so much more
- After reading, spend time quietly in His presence. Perhaps respond to what you've read by writing in a journal. How is this passage impacting my life?

Think about it! It is an amazing honor to be able to spend focused time with our Lord God Almighty every day — and to hear Him speak directly into our hearts. Spending time with HIM makes all the difference. The Holy Spirit knows exactly what we need exactly when we need it. Sometimes He'll bring a fresh word from a familiar passage, other times He'll bring enlightenment on one we've never noticed before. Get ready for your faith to grow!
